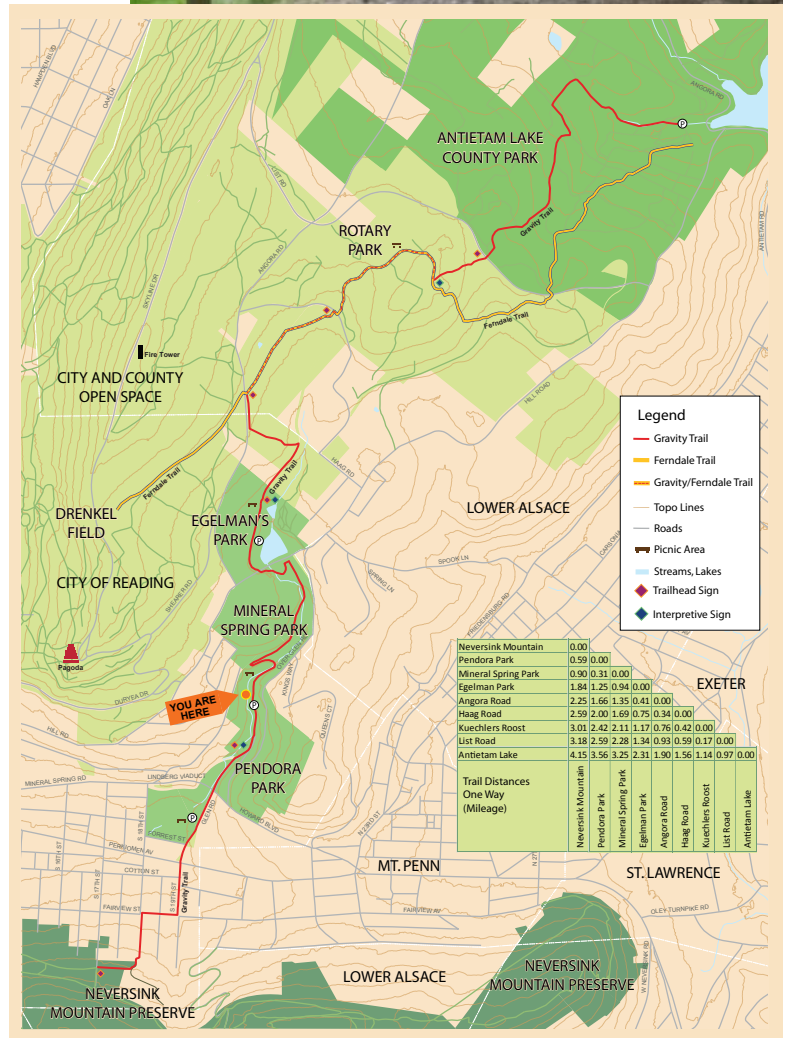
## Berks Conservancy works with Safeguards Specialized Foster Teens to Improve Mineral Spring Park

The Berks Conservancy is working with foster teens to improve Mineral Spring Park in Reading this Tuesday and Wednesday. The foster teens are installing a split rail fence as a barrier between the trail and a drop down to Rose Creek. The fence installation is in preparation for the Gravity Trail signs that will be finished this fall. The organization helping the Berks Conservancy is called Safeguards Specialized Foster Care Program. It is a program of Reading Specialists Educational Association.



### About the Gravity Trail

The Gravity Trail connects the Neversink Mountain Preserve to the county-owned Antietam Lake Park. Traveling through City of Reading owned Pandora Park, Mineral Spring Park and Egelman’s Park, there are many opportunities to picnic and rest in the public parks pavilions. This linear trail can be hiked in one direction if you shuttle cars, or you can pick a section to create an out-and-back hike.
